



Here is the latest news about Norton taken from the March 3, 1999 issue of MCN (Motorcycle News)

NEW MANX TO BLAST FIRM BACK INTO BIGTIME

A prototype 750 Norton superbike was seen out on the road in a secret test session. The location was a desolate moorland in Lancashire on a freezing February morning. The reason for the test was to see if the fuel-injection system which feeds the in-line 4 motor was working.

This was only the second time the prototype was seen ridden. The sound and sight of the 16-valve machine firing into life was a milestone in Norton's comeback. The bike did start but only after the rear wheel was perched on a home-made starting rig driven by the front wheels of the design teams van.

The bike returned after just a few minutes with the engine sounding as though it was running on three cylinders. This prototype motor was fitted with only one plug per cylinder. The new World Superbike Manx contender engine will be fitted with 3 plugs per cylinder.

This time the bike ran well. Design chief Al Melling has restricted the throttle movement to prevent opening the bike all the way up to prevent

damage to the new engine. The rider said that it was difficult to come to any conclusions about the engine at this stage. He felt it feels similar to a conventional in-line four but it seemed to have more pulling power in the low rev range. Technicians will use these results to start setting up the engine for full power delivery.

NEMESIS WILL BE READY FOR OWNERS IN JUNE

The 220mph-plus Nemesis could be roaring on the road before June.

To satisfy the demand, Norton is likely to start handbuilding one bike a week at its Rochdale HQ before full production begins later this year. At best, production will only be around 3 bikes per week as they will be all habd built.

The Nemesis will have a 230bhp motor and a top speed of 220mph. Al Melling says that he has been under tremendous pressure from Norton America to get things rolling.

MCN saw a brief moment of it hitting 10,000 rpm when the V-8 engine was blipped, producing a roar more like an F1 racing car than a motorcycle. All the tooling needed to make the bike has been completed and ready to ship to sub-contractors where Norton sources its components.


Melling confirms that there are 24 firm orders for the Nemesis, which is enough for six months.

Only after it starts producing 3 bikes a week will the firm be in the black even though the price is over £27,000. Most of the buyers come from the United States where Norton's comeback is causing quite a stir. Technically the V-8 is a doubled up 750 four. It shares identical geardriven camshafts and cylinder heads. Many internal parts are shared with the Manx. It will even dispense with rear view mirrors in favour of a rear mounted camera and a screen

V-TWIN ON TRACK FOR AUTUMN


The giant V-twin Nirvana will follow the Nemesis into production this autumn. It is a 1640cc V-twin cruiser. It was rushed into production when it became clear that the V8 Commando was running late.

Even though it is a a rush job, Melling has detailed the design to make it look like a pair of 1950s Norton cylinders with a typically British timing case. It will have 2 valves per cylinder and will have a mild power delivery.





The NEW Norton Motor Corp.'s prototype "The Nemesis"






750cc Rickman Metisse-Norton


